

Annual Public Notification August 2022

The White Pigeon School District presently operates an asbestos management program in accordance with the Asbestos Emergency Response Act (AHERA) of 1986, 1987. This plan is presently on file at the state of Michigan Asbestos Program and the EPA Region V in Chicago, Illinois. All known asbestos containing material (ACMs) have been documented in the "Management Plan" and are available for the public review in the main office of each school.

In 2022 the district has performed asbestos abatement as part of an ongoing sinking fund project. Materials were abated from White Pigeon High/ Middle School classrooms 1, 6, 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, 15, 17, 20, 21, 22, 23, Cafeteria, and School counselor's office. Materials were abated from White Pigeon Central Elementary office c 122. This material was removed in accordance with all applicable state and federal regulations and was disposed of in a landfill licensed to accept ACM waste.

The school district satisfies the requirements of AHERA and OHSA by performing surveillance to assure that ACM conditions do not change and has been documented annual asbestos training for all of its affected employees.
