# Free & Low-Cost Preschool in St Joseph County

Children 4 years of age by December 1, 2021

**Step 1: Apply** [www.StJosephCountyPreschool.org](http://www.StJosephCountyPreschool.org)

**Step 2: Schedule** an Eligibility Assessment Appointment (EAA)

Sign up for an EAA using the link you are emailed once you submit your online application. *\*Note that due to COVID-19, these dates are subject to change. You will receive an email notification once new dates/procedures are established so please make sure to include a valid email address in the sign up. Please call (269) 467-5400 if you are having technical difficulties accessing the link.*

**Step 3: Submit** ALL required documentation

1. 2020 Tax forms OR 2020 W2 OR 2 consecutive pay stubs and/or any other documentation verifying ALL forms of family income (child support, social security, unemployment, etc.)
2. OFFICIAL birth certificate
3. Proof of residency - picture of parent/guardian's driver's license OR utility bill with Michigan address

***ALL paperwork must be submitted in order for your child to be enrolled in preschool***

**Step 4: Notification** of which program your child is qualified for

Preschools Include:

- Head Start - If a family is income eligible, Head Start MUST be offered to the family. Head Start will call to offer this opportunity (Free)
- Great Start Readiness Program (GSRP) - State Funded preschool which is free or low cost for families
- Private Preschool- Tuition based
