We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2021-22 educational progress for Central Elementary. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2021-22 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2018-19. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest $5 \%$ of all schools in the state in 2017-18. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest $5 \%$ of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below $67 \%$ in 2016-17. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not been given one of these labels.
Central Elementary has one computer lab that has allowed us to be able to utilize more computer time for students, but recently we have Chromebooks for all Y5-5th grade students. Now that we have lab space and portable devices in the classrooms, we are able to incorporate online assessing and learning more often with our students. We have also had intensive training in reading routines for grades K -2nd and intensive writing instruction professional development for all grades K-5th. We are in year six of our reading series that is very rigorous and is aligned to State Standards. We believe that our content is good, but feel that we needed to work on our actual instruction in the classroom insuring that our teachers are instructing with best practice techniques. We believe that ensuring that good instructional techniques that are research based in both reading and writing, we will see an increase in our proficiency levels.
