We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2022-23 educational progress for the Central Elementary. For the 2022-2023 school year, schools were identified using new definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2021-22. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has three or more underperforming student subgroups. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2020-21. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has not been given one of these labels.

We have Chromebook carts in all classes. Now that we have portable devices in the classrooms, we are able to incorporate online assessing and learning more often with our students. We have also had intensive training in reading routines for grades K-2nd and intensive writing instruction professional development for all grades K-5th. We are in year one of our reading series that is very rigorous and aligned to State Standards. We believe our content is good but feel we needed to work on our actual instruction in the classroom insuring our teachers are instructing with best practice techniques. We believe good instructional techniques, that are research based in both reading and writing, will allow for an increase in our proficiency levels.

All students who reside in White Pigeon are assigned to attend the elementary building. In addition, some school of choice students attend our school from throughout the county.

The School Improvement Plan for Central Elementary is updated every spring. The content areas of Reading, Writing, Science, Social Studies and Mathematics are addressed. Measurable objectives for improvement have been identified, as well as strategies and action steps for implementation with the vision of increasing student achievement thought out our building.
